

Cookie Policy

RealFi Foundation (together with our affiliates and subsidiaries, “RealFi,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) understands that your privacy is important to you and we are committed to being transparent about the technologies used. This Cookie Policy explains how and why cookies may be stored on and accessed through the RealFi website, the RealFi testnet, and the RealFi decentralized application (the “dApp”), together with any related interfaces, plug-ins, and browser extensions (collectively, the “Products”). This Cookie Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy and Terms of Service.

What are cookies?

Our Products, like many others, use cookies in order to work properly.

Cookies are small text files, often including unique identifiers, that are downloaded onto your device when you access our Products. They allow us to recognize your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions on our website, ultimately allowing us to improve your experience. Cookies are very useful and enhance your user experience. In this policy, references to cookies also include similar technologies, such as pixel tags, browser local storage, and session storage, which our website, testnet, and dApp may use to function.

How we use cookies

We or our third-party partners may collect information using cookies, pixel tags, or similar technologies. We use cookies to provide you with services, to set your preferences, and to understand how you interact with our Products and thus how we can improve them. Our third-party partners, such as analytics providers, may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities while using our Products.

The types of cookies that may be used by RealFi (see the specific Product cookie banner for more details)

Necessary/Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the Products to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms. In the dApp, these technologies help maintain your wallet-connection session and protect against fraudulent use.

Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us to understand how users engage with the Products. We may use a set of cookies to collect information and report site usage statistics. This helps us improve our Products. On the testnet, these insights help us evaluate performance before mainnet release.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalization, such as remembering your preferences, your selected network (for example, testnet or mainnet), your language, and your wallet-connection settings. If you disable these cookies, some or all of these features may stop working properly.

Targeting and Advertising Cookies

RealFi does not use advertising or targeting cookies on its website, testnet, or dApp.

Cookies and Similar Technologies in the dApp and Testnet

The dApp is a self-custodial interface to the RealFi protocol. When you connect a wallet, your wallet software and the underlying blockchain process your interactions, and on-chain transactions are public and fall outside this Cookie Policy. The dApp may use browser local storage and session storage to maintain your wallet-connection state, your selected network, and your interface preferences.

The RealFi testnet is a non-production, experimental environment provided for testing and evaluation. Cookies and similar technologies used on the testnet support testing, diagnostics, and stability, and the data collected there is used to develop and improve the Products. Testnet activity should be treated as test data and may be reset or deleted at any time.

How to Manage or Disable Cookies

Most browsers let you refuse or delete cookies through their settings, and you can clear local storage and session storage for a site from your browser. If you block necessary cookies, parts of the Products, including wallet connection, may stop working. For guidance, visit www.allaboutcookies.org or, in Europe, www.youronlinechoices.eu.

Your Consent

Necessary cookies are required for the Products to operate and do not require your consent. Where consent is required for other categories, we request it through a cookie banner or similar control. By continuing to use the Products after setting your preferences, you consent to our use of cookies as described in this policy.
